**SUBJECT: ONE-WEEK DELAY IN FY2017 FEDERAL BUDGET FOR EDUCATION**

Resolution of the federal budget for FY 2017, which includes current government spending and education spending for school year 2017-2018, is to be postponed another week until Friday, May 5. The proposed one-week stopgap measure is expected to be signed by today to avert a government shutdown, following two previous budget delays (the first until December 9, 2016, and a second until April 28, 2017, each with small spending reductions across the board). The one-week extension, following the debate over new funding for a national border wall, provides more time for final negotiations on discretionary budget items including education. The District continues to advocate for no reduction in education spending.
